Fossil Fuel Generation Efficiency

Western Indiana Rural Electric Membership Corporation (WIN Energy REMC) is a rural electric distribution cooperative located in southwestern Indiana. On August 8th 2005 the Energy Policy Act of 2005 was signed into law. Under this new law, electric utilities that sell in excess of 500 million KWH in retail electric sales are required to consider the standard under PURPA Section 1251. The clear intent of this law is to promote renewable energy and energy efficiency.

As stated above, WIN Energy REMC is an electric distribution cooperative. WIN Energy REMC is a member of Hoosier Energy REC (<http://www.hepn.com>), which is the generation and transmission supplier for the cooperative. WIN Energy REMC has a contractual obligation to purchase its power from Hoosier Energy REC and due to that fact, this part of the regulation does not directly apply to WIN energy REMC.

WIN Energy REMC is committed to the efficient use of our nation's resources and encourages Hoosier Energy REC to continually review the availability of improvements in fossil fuel efficiency.
