A scholarship program has been established for graduating seniors that meet the qualifications listed below. Applications must be submitted to the WIN Energy REMC office no later than 4:30 p.m. ET on February 17, 2023. Applications can be downloaded from our website and completed electronically. Scholarship funds will be disbursed to the student upon proof of enrollment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The parents/legal guardians of the applicant must be WIN Energy REMC members.
- Applicant must be a 2023 graduating senior and have maintained a cumulative grade point average of a C or higher. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript is required.
- Scholarship funds may be applied toward tuition or course fees at any recognized two-year or four-year college or trade school.
- Recipients must be enrolled as a full time student in the fall of 2023.
 Proof of enrollment must be presented to WIN Energy REMC.
- Full or part-time employees of WIN Energy REMC; or a spouse, son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, grandchild, brother, sister, aunt, uncle, niece or nephew of an employee or director of WIN Energy REMC are ineligible to apply.
